



Commissioners-legislators meeting postponed

December 16, 2010

HICKORY, NC -- A scheduling conflict has forced commissioners to cancel a meeting with legislators.

The Catawba County Board of Commissioners was supposed to meet with area state officials to talk about how legislators can help the county. The meeting was set for 3 p.m. Monday in the Government Center in Newton.

Commissioners planned to hold their regular meeting following the get-together with legislators.

But now commissioners are holding their meeting at 4 p.m. Monday at the 1924 Courthouse in Newton, according to information from the county.

Commissioners will consider adopting the Carolina Thread Trail Master Plan. The plan calls for a network of greenways, trails and waterways in 15 counties. The counties include Anson, Cabarrus, Catawba, Cherokee, Chester, Cleveland, Gaston, Iredell, Lancaster, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, Rowan, Stanley, Union and York, according to information from the county.

Private donations and state and federal funding would fund the needed work, the information says.

In other business, commissioners will consider the risk and needs priorities for the Catawba County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council.
