



Matthews misses Carolina Thread Trail grant

Carolina Thread Trail recently awarded \$536,795 in grants to community trail projects, but Matthews did not get money to design more trails.

Earlier this year, Matthews officials applied for a grant to design a greenway trail connecting the KP Park and Matthews Station Street Extension to the hospital and, subsequently, to Independence Pointe Parkway.

The Carolina Thread Trail is a 15-county, two-state initiative to help create a regional network of trails, blueways and conservation corridors that "is growing together to link more than 2.3 million people in the area."
