



Public input sought for Carolina Thread Trail

STATESVILLE – Iredell County is continuing to develop a countywide master plan for the Carolina Thread Trail, a network of trails and greenways linking 15 counties in the Carolinas.

The trail offers opportunities for biking, hiking, fishing, paddling and connecting with nature.

Beginning Nov. 18, a series of public workshops will be held throughout the county to gather additional public input. The meetings will take place from 7 to 8:30 p.m. on the following dates:

- Nov. 18 at the Union Grove Community Center, 1869 W. Memorial Hwy., Harmony;
- Nov. 29 at the Iredell County Agricultural Resource Center, 444 Bristol Drive, Statesville;
and
- Nov. 30 at Pine Lake Preparatory School, 1639 Mecklenburg Hwy., Mooreville.
