Carolina Thread Trail surpasses 100th Resolution of Support

The Carolina Thread Trail has received its 100th resolution of support from the Town of Wingate, representing at least one entity from every county within the 15-county footprint. The resolutions of support indicate community commitment, in concept, to work with neighboring communities and with the Carolina Thread Trail to plan, design and build a system of trails that will connect our communities, people and special regional points of interest for years to come.

The Carolina Thread Trail is a regional network of trails, blueways and conservation corridors. Local communities plan and build their portions of the green interstate system with technical resources and catalytic funding provided by The Thread. Catawba Lands Conservancy is the Lead Agency for The Thread.

“Gaining 100 Resolutions of Support is a major milestone for The Thread,” said Ann Browning, Carolina Thread Trail Project Director. “In little more than one year, we have reached out to governments and organizations in all 15 counties, educating on the benefits of a regional trail system, including improved health, economic development, social connections, and preservation of natural areas. By supporting The Thread they are taking part in an initiative that will change our landscape and our lives.”

“Through cooperation and community building, the Carolina Thread Trail will truly be greater than the sum of its parts,” said Rob Youngblood, President of the York County Regional Chamber. “Each organization and governmental entity that resolves to support The Thread adds another piece to a puzzle that will transform our region, connecting communities, places, and lives in a way that we are only beginning to experience.
