



## **Check out Rock Hill's Riverwalk Trail for a nice break**

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If you're driving into South Carolina from Interstate 77 and need to stretch your legs, check out [Rock Hill's new Riverwalk Trail](#), a 2 ¼-mile asphalt path offering scenic views of the Catawba River.

Part of the Carolina Thread Trail — a regional network of trails and greenways spanning 15 counties in the Carolinas — the 10-foot wide Riverwalk meanders through the woods and includes some flat areas and sections traversing hills with steep grades. It can be used by walkers, joggers and cyclists and is handicapped accessible. Fido is also welcome, but you'll need to keep him on a three-foot long leash.

Trail hours are 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. October through March; 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. April through September.

From I-77, take Exit 82A in [Rock Hill](#) and drive .8 miles on Cherry Road (Highway 21) toward Fort Mill. Turn right on Dunkin's Ferry Road at the Riverwalk sign, then left onto Terrace Park and continue to the trail's parking lot.

[Riverwalk](#) is a planned 1,000-acre residential, commercial and retail community being developed along the Catawba River. Approximately 250 acres will be devoted to public recreation amenities, including river access, athletic fields, parks, gardens, a climbing wall, a variety of cycling venues and additional trails.
