

**Construction on Riverwalk homes to begin in fall**

Saussy Burbank and Evans Coghill Homes have signed on to build the first houses in Riverwalk, Rock Hill's 1,008-acre, mixed-use development on the banks of the Catawba River.

Riverwalk is on a three-mile stretch of the Carolina Thread Trail system along the banks of the river. It is home to the Rock Hill Outdoor Center, where a velodrome is under construction. Mountain biking trails, kayak and canoe launches, a YMCA, athletic fields, parks and a town center also are planned.

Home in Riverwalk are expected to start at \$200,000, with construction starting this fall.
