



## **Broad River Greenway**

### **Shelby, NC**

The Broad River Greenway is approximately 1,500 acres of protected land on both sides of the Broad River in Cleveland County. It is owned by Cleveland County and the Town of Boiling Springs and managed by the Broad River Council.

The Broad River Greenway joins more than 20 miles of multi-use trails along both sides of the river. A handicapped accessible interpretive area with educational displays is available. There is a fishing pier and canoe access, as well as a wooden playground and a number of points where one can rest on a bench, or enjoy a picnic with grills provided.

The Broad River has been an important part of this community for many generations. The name not only honors the River, but it also lets others know where the greenway is located.





## Directions and Parking

GPS Coordinates: 35° 22.259"N  
81° 10.583"W

**From Charlotte** -- Take I-85 South into South Carolina. Take Exit 95 and at the top of the exit ramp cross over and follow the SERVICE ROAD south running parallel to I-85. At the first stop sign make a right. This will be Highway 150. Continue NORTH on Highway 150 returning to North Carolina. Cross over the Broad River and the Greenway entrance is on the right. The Greenway and parking is approximately 8 miles from the Interstate on the right.

**From Greenville Spartanburg** -- Take I-85 North to exit 92. At the exit ramp take the SERVICE ROAD running North parallel to I-85. At the first stop sign make a left. This will be Highway 150. Continue NORTH on Highway 150 into North Carolina. Cross over the Broad River and the Greenway entrance is on the right. The Greenway and parking is approximately 8 miles from the Interstate on the right.

## Trail Length

Over 20 miles total; approximately 3 miles designated as Carolina Thread Trail
