



IRWIN CREEK AND STEWART CREEK GREENWAY

SEVERSVILLE PARK AT BRUNS AVENUE TO RAY'S SPLASH
PLANET AND IRWIN RECREATION CENTER

MECKLENBURG COUNTY – CHARLOTTE, NC

This Greenway runs below I-77 just outside of Uptown Charlotte. The proximity of the city gives greenway users unique and beautiful views of Charlotte. The trail is accessible at three different points, all near W. Trade Street. It runs through two parks and Ray's Splash Planet, with plenty of recreational opportunities in between.

Directions and Parking:

SEVERSVILLE PARK – The park is located northwest of Uptown Charlotte. From W. Trade Street (just west of I-77 and near the intersection with W. 5th Street) turn onto S. Bruns Avenue. Follow S. Bruns Avenue until it dead-ends after the Bruns Avenue Elementary School. Parking is on the left.

FRAZIER PARK – The park is located northwest of Uptown Charlotte. From W. Trade Street (just east of I-77) turn south onto S. Cedar Street. Turn right onto Greenleaf Avenue. Parking is at the end of Greenleaf Avenue.

 W 080° 51.434’

RAY’S SPLASH PLANET AND IRWIN RECREATION CENTER – The park is located northwest of Uptown Charlotte. From W. Trade Street (just east of I-77) turn onto N. Sycamore Street. Cross over W. 5th Street and Ray’s Splash Planet will be directly ahead. Parking is located on the left.

Points of Interest:

- Basketball Courts
- Lunch Pavilion
- Playground

Surface Type:

The greenway is a combination of gravel and asphalt paths.

Activities:

Due to the gravel surface in some sections, this greenway is most ideal for walkers, joggers, and bikers.

Trail Length:

From northern end of Seversville Park to Ray's Splash Planet is 2.1 miles.

Level of Difficulty:

Easy walk, with slight grades near Ray's Splash Planet

Pet Policy:

Pets are permissible on the Irwin and Stewart Creeks Greenway, though they must be leashed at all times. Most trailheads have garbage cans, as well as doggie bags for picking up after your pet.

Restrooms:

There are no public restroom facilities along this greenway

Fees and Hours:

There are no fees to use all Mecklenburg County Greenways. Trails are open daily from sunrise to sunset.
