Chester, South Carolina

This is an easy walk that starts at the parking lot and ends at the Spider Lilly Overlook. The trail follows the banks of the Catawba River and provides many river and wildlife viewing opportunities.

From Charlotte

Take exit 77 on Interstate 77, turn left on US 21 south /South Carolina 5/Anderson Road in approximately 10 miles turn left onto Landsford Road, in approximately 1.7 miles turn left onto Park Drive and arrive at Landsford Canal State Park.



From Columbia

Take exit 77 on Interstate 77, turn right onto US 21 south /South Carolina 5/Anderson Road travel approximately 10 miles and turn left onto Landsford Road, in approximately 1.7 miles turn left onto Park Drive and arrive at Landsford Canal State Park.

Trail length

Distance: .75 miles

Points of interest

Log Cabin circa 1790 has been moved and reconstructed on the site. There are picnic areas and a playground, as well as places to launch your canoe or kayak.

Surface type

This trail is constructed of crush and run gravel/cinders.
