



CLARK'S CREEK GREENWAY

SAXONBURY WAY TO COUNTRYSIDE MONTESSORI SCHOOL

MECKLENBURG COUNTY – CHARLOTTE, NC

This part of the greenway winds through a more secluded section of Clark's Creek. Crossing over several bridges along the way, watch for signs of wildlife on the banks of the creek. It connects the Saxonbury/Fairlea Drive section to Kirk Farm Fields via the University Research Park. The most common access point along this trail is at the Mallard Creek Elementary school, where there is an option to follow the greenway north or south. Just before the greenway reaches the University Research Park at the Countryside Montessori School, Clark's Creek is intersected by the Mallard Creek Greenway from the west.

Directions and Parking:

SAXONBURY WAY – There is parking along Saxonbury Way. Signs mark out allotted times and places to leave your vehicle. From Mallard Creek Road, turn left onto Prosperity Church Road. Take another left onto Katelyn Drive and turn right onto Saxonbury Way. Parking is available between Eagles Field Court and Netherhall Drive. The trail intersects Saxonbury Way between these two roads.

MALLARD CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL – This is the most common access point to the Clark's Creek Greenway. The school is located just off of Mallard Creek Road.

COUNTRYSIDE MONTESSORI SCHOOL – The trailhead is located directly behind the school, but parking is prohibited during school hours.

Surface Type:

This section of the Clark's Creek Greenway is paved asphalt.

Activities:

The smooth asphalt of this section make it ideal for anything from skateboarding to jogging.

Trail Length:

This section of the Clark's Creek Greenway is 2.1 miles.

Level of Difficulty:

Easy walk with level surfaces.

Pet Policy:

Pets are permissible on the Little Sugar Creek Greenway, though they must be leashed at all times. Most trailheads have garbage cans, as well as doggie bags for picking up after your pet.

Restrooms:

There are no public restroom facilities along this greenway.

Fees and Hours:

There are no fees to use all Mecklenburg County Greenways. Trails are open daily from sunrise to sunset.
