



McDOWELL CREEK GREENWAY

WESTMORELAND ROAD TO SAM FURR ROAD

MECKLENBURG COUNTY – HUNTERSVILLE, NC

This Greenway is a recently completed project that runs between Westmoreland Road and Sam Furr Road in Huntersville. The Greenway runs parallel with I-77 between the interstate and Lake Norman. The segment runs behind the residential of Huntersville and begins from the south end in the Birkdale Village, shopping center.

Directions and Parking:

The Birkdale Village parking lot is the best place to park while using this Greenway as the entrance at Westmoreland Road, is located immediately off of the busy road. The McDowell Creek Greenway is very easy to get to. From I-77, take exit 25 and head west on Sam Furr Road. Turn into Birkdale Village, by hanging right on Lindholm Drive. Keep right and loop around towards the back near Dick's Sporting Goods. The Greenway slopes down from the parking lot and then runs perpendicular away from Sam Furr Road.

Surface Type:

The Greenway is paved asphalt with one wooden bridge.

Trail Length:

The total distance of this Greenway is 1.5 miles.

Level of Difficulty:

Easy walk, with a slight grade at the northern end.

Pet Policy:

Pets are permissible on the McDowell Creek Greenway, though they must be leashed at all times. Most trailheads have garbage cans, as well as doggie bags for picking up after your pet.

Restrooms:

There are no public restroom facilities along this Greenway

Fees and Hours:

There are no fees to use all Mecklenburg County Greenways. Trails are open daily from sunrise to sunset.
