



# **Southeast Greenway**

## **MECKLENBURG COUNTY – DAVIDSON, NC**

This Greenway has multiple segments that run through the residential neighborhoods and outskirts of the beautiful town of Davidson. Users can choose to take each Greenway independently, or use the overland connectors to explore the entire pathway.

Directions and Parking:

**DAVIDSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** – Parking for this segment is available right at the school, but please observe parking signs for hours and daily use. From I-77 (exit 30) head east on Griffith Street, follow signs for Davidson College. Continue on Griffith (through 2 traffic circles) until it dead-ends at N. Main St. in Davidson. Take a right on N. Main St. follow until the street splits. Take a slight left at the fork onto South St. Follow South St. for about 0.75 miles and the Davidson Elementary will be on the left.

### Surface Type:

This section of the Southeast Greenway is paved asphalt.

### Trail Length:

The greenway is 0.6 miles from the Davidson Elementary School to Avinger Lane.

### Level of Difficulty:

Short, easy walk, with gradual inclines.

### Additional Information:

This segment of the Southeast Greenway is also known as the Randall R. Kincaid Trail. It was named for the mayor of Davidson, as recognition of his work and commitment to the town's parks and recreation.

## **SOUTHEAST GREENWAY DAVIDSON CONCORD ROAD TO HUDSON PLACE DAVIDSON, NC**

### Directions and Parking:

**DAVIDSON CONCORD ROAD** – Parking for this segment is available at the River Run Athletics Fields on (Davidson) Concord Road. From I-77 (exit 30) head east on Griffith Street, follow signs for Davidson College. Continue on Griffith (through 2 traffic circles) until it dead-ends at N. Main St. in Davidson. Take a right on N. Main St. follow until the street divides. Take a left on Concord Road. A couple of miles outside of town, Concord Road splits at a traffic circle. Take a slight right, where Concord Road now becomes Davidson Concord Road. After the split, the River Run Athletic Fields are located on the left at the intersection with Robert Walker Dr.

### Layout:

From the parking lot of the River Run Athletic Fields, users can cross Davidson Concord Road and follow Robert Walker Drive where it slopes downward until it intersects the Greenway segment that stretches from Hudson Place to Davidson Concord Road about 0.5 miles past the River Run Athletic Fields (from here, following Davidson Concord Road, one can walk on the shoulder back towards the River Run Athletic Fields). Users can also follow the Greenway back towards the village of Davidson.

The Davidson Elementary School Greenway can be reached from the River Run Athletic Fields by using Hudson Place-Davidson Concord Road segment and the overland connector from Hudson Place to Pine Road via Patrick Johnston Lane. There are signs that point users in the correct direction for the beginning of each new segment.

### Surface Type:

This section of the Southeast Greenway is paved asphalt.

### Trail Length:

The greenway is approximately 2.3 miles. (3.75 with overland connectors)

### Level of Difficulty:

Moderate, but lengthy, with several inclines. Use extreme caution on overland connectors that follow along busy roads.

### Bikers/Rollerbladers:

Bikers and Rollerbladers must wear helmets on the Greenway between Hudson Place and Davidson Concord Road.

### Pet Policy:

Pets are permissible on the Southeast Greenway, though they must be leashed at all times. Most trailheads have garbage cans, as well as doggie bags for picking up after your pet.

### Restrooms:

There are no public restroom facilities along this Greenway

### Fees and Hours:

There are no fees to use all Mecklenburg County Greenways. Trails are open daily from sunrise to sunset.
