



# **Torrence Creek Greenway**

SUMMERFIELD LANE TO CEDAR RIVER ROAD  
VIA BRADFORD HILL LANE ENTRANCE

**MECKLENBURG COUNTY – CHARLOTTE, NC**

This Greenway runs through residential neighborhoods of Huntersville, located just off I-77. The greenway can be accessed by one of its many overland neighborhood connectors. The path runs east and west along its namesake, Torrence Creek.

#### Directions and Parking:

**BRADFORD HILL LANE** – Parking for this greenway is fairly limited, and given its small distance, the Bradford Hill Lane parking is most ideal. This road bisects the greenway and gives users the option to follow the greenway toward Summerfield Lane or Cedar River Road. Parking is available on either side of the street. Signs on the east side of the trail provide a map and information about the Mecklenburg County Greenways.

#### Surface Type:

The Greenway is mostly asphalt, but there are sections where the wooden boardwalks are used.

#### Activities:

Walking, Running, Biking, are all permitted on this greenway. Users should use caution when crossing the oft slick boardwalks.

#### Trail Length:

From the western end at Summerfield Lane to the eastern entrance at Cedar River Road miles, the greenway is 0.8 miles.

### Level of Difficulty:

Easy walk, with flat surfaces throughout.

### Pet Policy:

Pets are permissible on the Torrence Creek Greenway, though they must be leashed at all times. Most trailheads have garbage cans, as well as doggie bags for picking up after your pet.

### Restrooms:

There are no public restroom facilities along this Greenway

### Fees and Hours:

There are no fees to use all Mecklenburg County Greenways. Trails are open daily from sunrise to sunset.
